Attendees will learn about the pedagogy behind Immerse and have a chance to try out the application.	Creating an Engaging and Inclusive Approach to Teaching Culture Through the Senses in K-8 Spanish Michelle Lange, <i>Lincoln Hall</i> <i>Middle School and AATSP</i> Teachers will create artifacts and learn hands-on ways to make the arts come alive in their classrooms!
